

Personnel Committee Report

I met with Ryan Donahoe in Gaylord on 08 Oct 2019 to effect a turnover of the chair of the Personnel committee to myself. We discussed processes, issues, and committee matters.

In the works: We have the submission of the self and peer reviews of both the stated clerk and the office manager in hand. My plan is to consolidate these reports and do a review of a proposed final report for each person via email with the committee in November. (I am on vacation in the latter half of October.) Reviews with personnel should occur the same month, but no later than by the end of the year.

The committee in a previous meeting has approved the idea of Raeann traveling in the Upper Peninsula to bring her expertise and the goodwill of the Presbytery to the whole presbytery. It is my understanding that money for this travel has already been budgeted. We decided that this activity would require a vote of the Coordinating Council, and so I propose the following motion:

“...that the Office Manager be allowed to travel to the Upper Peninsula to visit churches within the Mackinac Presbytery and that this travel be at the discretion of the Office Manager on the advice of the Coordinating Council (or a designated representative) with the planned travel costs not to exceed that budgeted by the Presbytery.”
